BONDED GRAVEL INSPECTION AND MAINTENANCE SCHEDULE

Bonded Gravel is a low maintenance product. However, it should undergo routine and operational inspection and maintenance to keep it in optimum condition.

The frequency of inspection will vary with the type of equipment used and other factors e.g. heavy use, levels of vandalism, coastal location, air pollution, location adjacent trees.

INSPECTION SCHEDULE

Routine Visual Inspection

A routine visual inspection is recommended. This should consist of the following as a minimum:

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| • All debris should be removed from the surface by brushing or by using a leaf blower. It is important to prevent organic matter from building up. Letting it accumulate will affect drainage and also encourage weed growth. | |
| Weeds | |
| Moss and weed killing should take place once a year or as required, ensuring that there is no accumulating vegetation on the surface. | |
| Please also ensure that when the moss and weeds have died off, all dead matter, including roots are removed. | |
